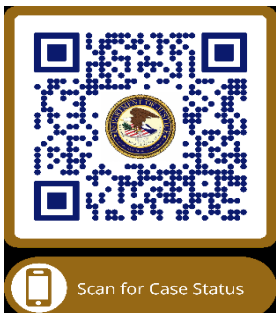

What is the Family Group Legal Orientation Program (FGLOP)?

3. Seeking the assistance of a **legal representative**.

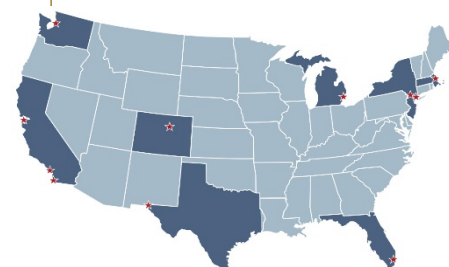
