WISe:

Wraparound with Intensive Services



WISe is an intensive mental health program for youth and their families that focuses on improving wellness, safety and relationships within the family and community. Our program serves children and youth who are at risk of being removed from their homes because of behavioral and mental health needs. **WISe provides:**

- Assessment of individual needs for youth. We use the Wraparound process to help you create a plan of care based on family strengths and culture. We work with you to implement the plan.
- Assistance with identifying support systems you already have in your family's life. We leverage those supports to help you reach your desired success.
- Flexibility for your family. We are able to work at the times and locations that are best for you. You'll also have access to an after-hours crisis line.



Health. Justice. Hope.

When other strategies haven't worked, it's time to try WISe.

Who is Eligible: Any youth under 21 who is covered by Medicaid and has a qualifying mental health diagnosis. Family and youth participate voluntarily and must live in Spokane County.

Who Participates: Families with youth who have a history of behavioral and mental health challenges, or have experienced trauma that significantly impacts daily life. Youth behavior can include:

- Anxiety and depression.
- Running away or frequent arrests related to mental health concerns.
- Increased risk of harm to themselves or others.

We also work with youth involved in multiple systems including: Child Protective Services, Juvenile Justice, Department of Disabilities Administration, Special Education and more.
