

Our hearts are filled with gratitude and a sense of purpose as we reflect on 2023. Your encouragement, generous giving, and sacrificial service remain the foundation of Safe Families for Children Treasure Valley, and we are honored to present the highlights of our journey together.

Nationally, Safe Families for Children is celebrating 20 years of serving and strengthening over 40,000 families! Our Treasure Valley chapter launched in 2021 and this year, the need has increased tenfold as so many parents are struggling to meet the basic needs of their family. Because of our generous donors and active volunteers, we have been able to meet that need head on. This report illustrates the impact of investing in prevention and the simple notion of families helping families.

We believe in the power of compassion to change lives and transform communities. Since we opened our doors, we have kept 204 children safe and 79 families together, creating a ripple effect of possibility and stability in the lives of those we serve. It is because of you-volunteers, donors, and community partners- that we have been able to invest more deeply in parents and children and provide hope to families who had nowhere else to turn. Each family's story of hope is a testament to your hospitality, generosity, and compassion being lived out locally.

As we press on in 2024, we do so with great faith, knowing that we have a committed community of dedicated individuals willing to learn, grow and give towards keeping children safe and families together.

Stories of Hope RADICAL HOSPITALITY



"It was midnight and Safe Families staff gathered at the Boise airport to meet a baby, her mom, and a volunteer host family. The baby's father had taken her out of state and then abandoned her on a doorstep. Baby was placed into foster care and somewhere along the way, she was harmed. We supported mom to bring her baby back home. Today, baby is getting lots of love and staying with a Safe Families' host family while her mom, a full time student, works on how to be a mom and finding a new home. The families visit weekly and mom breathes a sigh of relief -- without Safe Families I wouldn't have my baby."








HOW IT WORKS

Through a network of compassionate volunteers, we create extended family-like supports for parents who are struggling, alone and unable to care for their children as they would like. From hosting children in approved volunteer homes to connecting parents with tools and resources, Safe Families helps fill in the gaps to keep children safe and parents supported so that families can get back on their feet.







HOST FAMILIES

Open your home to care for children for a few hours, overnight or up to 6 months.



FAMILY COACHES

Mentor & walk alongside parents to help them reach their goals.



FAMILY FRIENDS

Support families with meals, babysitting, transportation, etc. or just a listening ear.



RESOURCE FRIENDS

Provide goods and services such as cribs or haircuts.



MINISTRY LEADS

Recruit volunteers through your church to put faith into action!



Safe Families for Children:

- Is an evidence-based child abuse prevention program
- Reduces trauma and is helping families thrive in 40 states
- Began in Idaho in 2021 after legislation was passed
- Is a voluntary, safe option for parents
